SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES (SSVF)

VLP has received a significant increase in our Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program funded through the VA.

Additional funds are available to assist eligible Veterans who have been impacted by COVID-19 within our grant's 18 county service delivery area.

All Veterans in need of assistance with rental payments, rental arrears, utility costs, moving costs, or emergency housing such as hotels if experiencing homelessness should contact VLP to be screened for eligibility.

HOUSING STABILIZATION PROGRAM (HSP)

VLP has been granted funding through the Housing Stabilization Program, a housing crisis-prevention program designed to promote the economic independence of City of Pittsburgh residents experiencing a temporary crisis by providing short-term financial assistance in order to access or maintain safe, stable, and affordable permanent housing.

<u>Financial assistance available for:</u>
First/last month's rent, rental arrears, or utility costs

Who may be eligible for the Program?
Renters at or below 50% area median income who live in the City of Pittsburgh or will be moving into the City of Pittsburgh

Veterans in need of assistance should contact VLP to be screened for eligibility.
